Dear Parents, Guardians, and Caregivers,

On December 6, 2023, the Board of Trustees, during the Regular Board Meeting, approved motions to begin a process of consultation on school consolidation and up to and including closure. This process also includes the potential for new schools to be built in Wetaskiwin Regional Public Schools jurisdiction.

The motions passed on December 6, 2023, were:

Whereas Wetaskiwin Regional Public Schools has submitted an application for a new K-12 build at Buck Lake,

1. That the Board directs the Superintendent to proceed with further consultations on the consolidation of K-6 Schools in the Buck Lake Family of Schools. Consultation will include the Pigeon Lake Family of schools so as the impact is fully understood. The Superintendent will provide recommendations to the Board by March 31, 2024.

Whereas an application has been made for a new K-8 build in the city of Wetaskiwin,

2. That the Board direct the superintendent to proceed with further consultation on the consolidation and potential reconfiguration of K-6 and K-8 schools in the city of Wetaskiwin and provide recommendation to the Board by March 31, 2024.

3. That the Board of Trustees direct the Superintendent to provide recommendations including the approval of new builds and the denial of new builds across WRPS.

We are committed to advancing discussions through consultations regarding potential new builds and considerations for no builds in the context of consolidation. The dates for consultation will be sent next week.

Your participation, and input in these discussions are invaluable as we collectively shape the future of our educational community. We hope that you find the time to come and engage with us so that we can gather your feedback on the future of our schools.


